
From its historic hospitals to its cutting-edge research centers, the city brings together the old and the new in a way that feels just right for a congress about transformation.


Looking for a more casual option? **Les Blouses Blanches**, near the dinner venue, offers a friendly, budget-friendly alternative for a relaxed evening.
